



Te Pahu School Swimming Pool Rules

1. Children must be supervised at all times. No one should ever swim alone. Anyone under 16 years MUST be supervised by someone 16 years or older.
2. No food or alcohol is to be inside the pool fence.
3. No running around the pool area or jumping into the swimming pool.
4. The pool area is to be left clean and tidy. Dispose of all rubbish in the bin provided, or take it home with you.
5. Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the school grounds, including the swimming pool area. We are a Smokefree School.
6. Enter the pool clean without dirt on body or togs, it is not a bath.
7. The key is for your immediate families use. Do not let other non-key holders use your key.
8. **The pool is open until 7.55pm weekdays and from 11.00 am to 7.55pm weekends. Testing is done at 8pm so all users must be out of the pool area by this time. From the 18th-22nd December & 3-5th and 8-12th January, swimming lessons will be on in the mornings so the pool is available from 1.30 pm.**
9. A First Aid Kit will be available in the toilet area in case of emergencies. Any use of this kit must be reported to the school office so that stocks can be replenished.
10. The toilets are open and available so please ensure they are used and left clean.
11. Pool Key is \$60 for the season. No deposit however please return the pool key promptly at the end of the season to be eligible for a key the next season.

DISCLAIMER: The School Board of Trustees shall not be liable or responsible for loss or damage to any school property, or for any death, accident, loss, or injury arising out of the use of the pool. Any person using the pool shall indemnify the school board of trustees for all actions, claims, suits, demands, costs and proceedings that may be made against them, or any of them, arising out of or in connection with the use of the pool.

The school board of trustees and/or pool committee reserve the right to evict any person(s) from the pool for not conforming to these conditions. They also reserve the right to alter the above conditions without notice. Infringements will result in confiscation of the key.
