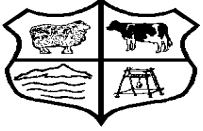

We have reviewed our reporting procedures from last year and have included a midyear written report to our schedule. A letter to explain what you should expect to see will be in the learning journey. Teachers have written a report for your child that summarises your child's learning so far this year and their next steps in learning, focusing on literacy and mathematics. These will be sent home on Friday 25 June allowing time for you to discuss the report with your child and record your thoughts and goals in the parent comment section. We will follow the report with parent interviews on Tuesday 27 and Wednesday 28 July, Week two of term three. This will provide more time before the end of year to focus on achieving goals set by each child, parent and teacher.

We have already considered further changes to the new report, as we had to provide enough time to write them we settled on this format on this occasion. We will be seeking feedback to improve the report further once the full reporting process is complete.
